Position Summary:

Provide pastoral care, spiritual inspiration, and counseling for the St. John's Northwestern Academies (SJNA) community. Collaborate with the SJNA leadership, school counselor, faculty, and resident life professionals with supportive counseling and advice for students' emotional and spiritual needs, including their families, and others while respecting diverse beliefs and cultures. As a significant SJNA you have the opportunity to play an essential role in a young person's life and future. Because SJNA is a boarding school, as the Chaplain, you have unique opportunities not present in traditional day-school settings. Also, the demands placed on academic members at SJNA exceed those of a traditional day school. As the SJNA Chaplain, one must think beyond their assigned duties and understand their role as more than just a job but a vocation that is a rewarding experience.

- Conduct or coordinate religious services for a diverse community.

- Provide consultation to students, faculty, and staff with ethical decision making and values while making appropriate referrals as needed.
