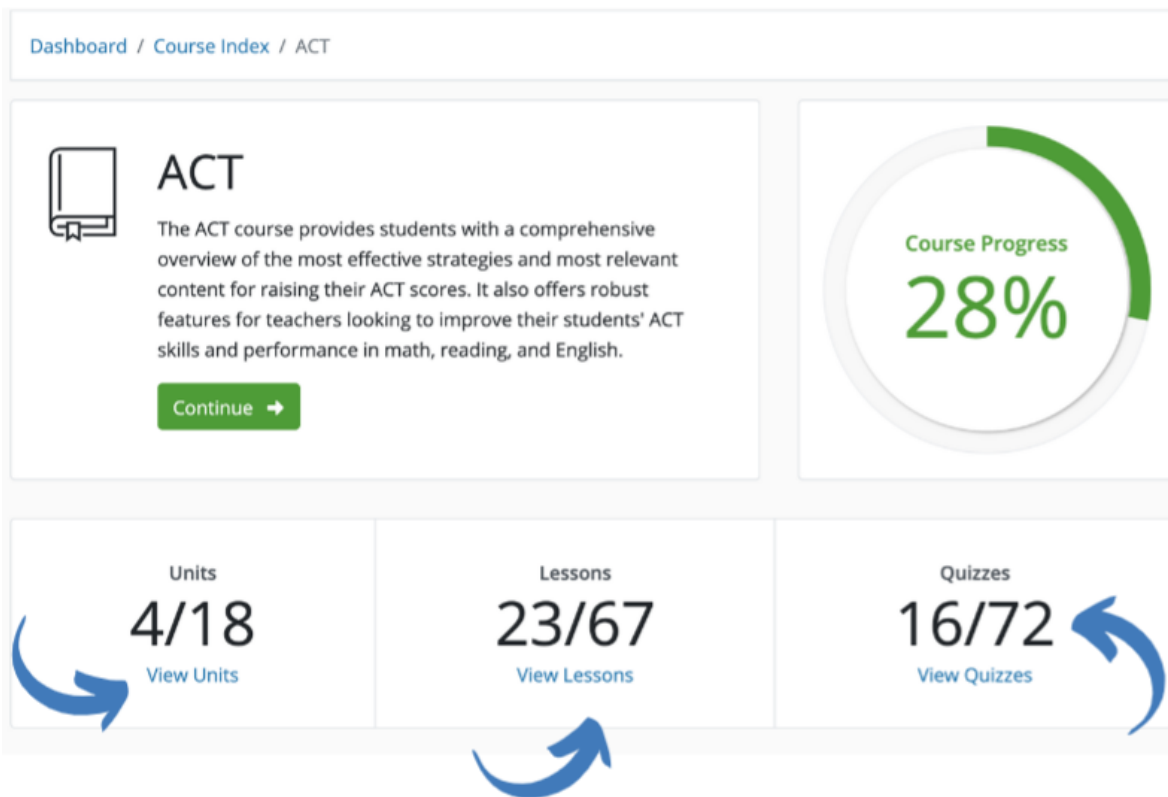

ACT and SAT Prep

All students enrolled at SJNA have free access to Methodize Test Prep – an online learning platform designed to help students prepare for ACT and SATs. It is a self-paced course and a simple, effective tool that empowers students to learn by using custom-built courses that consist of lessons, units, quizzes and tests. Not only will students be tested on their comprehension of the concepts being taught, but this program also features tutoring elements and gives students a chance to review detailed text and video explanations of the correct answers.

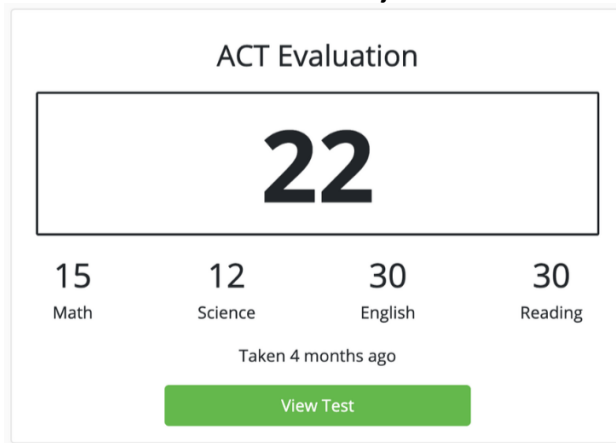


Methodize Test Prep also includes Evaluation Tests, which establish a “baseline score” by identifying their initial strengths and weakness so they can focus on areas where improvement is needed. It also features a vocabulary builder for students to familiarize themselves with the kind of “college-level” vocabulary found in the reading passages of the ACT and SAT. Finally, the course includes two full-length practice ACT and SATs for an authentic practice experience. Full-length tests are the best practice they can do

for the ACT and SAT to test their aptitude, test-taking strategies, stamina and content knowledge. Students will receive a score scaled just like the real test.



Collectively as a school, high schoolers at SJNA have already answered more than 1,500 questions and spent more than 40 hours in the Methodize Test Prep program this week. Students in College and Career Planning are given 30 minutes each week in class to work in this program and begin sharpening their study skills, while other core subject classes will begin integrating Methodize into their curriculum soon. Students can also log in and utilize the program on their own at any time and as frequently as they'd like.
